






How has your income been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic?






COVID Impact on Persistence Dashboard

Spring 2020 to Fall 2020 Persistence by Overall and Overall




Spring 2020 to Fall 2020 Persistence by Ethnicity and Overall



Spring 2020 to Fall 2020 Persistence by Spring Withdraw Status and Overall




Student Demographics by Spring Withdraw Status and Overall





Spring 2020 to Fall 2020 Persistence by Direct Financial Support and Overall




Student Demographics by Direct Financial Support and Overall




