California Community Colleges Respond to the President's Budget

On behalf of the California community colleges, the Community College League of California and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office has written a statement to our congressional delegation regarding the impacts of the President's recently released "skinny budget". This would reduce federal support for our state's community colleges by well over \$300 million annually - an impact that would prevent many students from completing their programs, ultimately keeping them from entering the workforce with the skills and training California's employers need.
