#### Office of Resource Development Updates

Thanks to the generous support of Faculty, Classified Professionals, Administrators, and friends of Mesa College, we raised over \$44,000 for scholarships, which will allow us to offer over \$120,000 in scholarships and incentives this year. Also thanks to many of our SDCCD community, we raised over

\$1,500 for #GivingTuesday. This week, we brought in \$20,700 in donations and accepted an in-kind donation of tribal artworks from Africa, Indonesia, and Asia worth \$44,000. Mesa College Foundation Board Member Aviva McPherron, VP at Nuvasive, was named in the Top 25 Healthcare Technology CTOs of 2022 by The Healthcare Technology Report. In the fall, we opened up our Innovation Grant cycle, which awards funds to various projects that forward the mission of Mesa College. This year, our committee reviewed 17 Innovation Grant applications totaling \$32,000 in funding requests. On the subject of grants, the Foundation has supported a \$20,000 grant from MUFG Union Bank for our Virtual Small Business Incubator. The Foundation also began preparation for the FY21-22 Audit.

# Office of Institutional Effectiveness Updates

The results for the 2022 campus-wide Environmental Sustainability Survey are out. The Office of Institutional Research conducted the survey during the fall to collect actionable data to inform San Diego Mesa College's first Climate Action Plan and other sustainability initiatives. The Environmental Sustainability Survey Report was a collaborative effort between the Environmental Sustainability Committee and the Institutional Research Office in support of the Roadmap to Mesa2030, which calls for the development of a climate action plan.
