## Office of Instruction Updates

Mesa faculty members, Dr. Veronica Gerace, Dr. Janue Johnson, Dr. Edeama Jonah, and Dr. Manuel Velaz presented at the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Statewide Symposium on Equal Employment Opportunities in Anaheim, California on Friday, March 17th. Their presentations on ideas for hiring and retraining diverse faculty were shared with state senators to highlight funding imperatives.





Professor Kelly Spoon was invited as

one of

the keynote presenters for the U.S. Conference on Teaching Statistics (USCOTS). USCOTS is a bi-annual conference held in odd-numbered years focused on enabling teachers of statistics to exchange ideas and improve their teaching. The theme for USCOTS 2023 is Communicating with/about Data and Kelly's keynote presentation will focus on course design choices to ensure students are ready to communicate

about data. Additionally, Kelly was selected as a member of the Desmos Classroom Fellowship program for 2023. Desmos Classroom is an interactive online tool that Professors Kelly Spoon and Rachel Russell (GIS) presented about at Catalyst 2021 in a workshop called <u>Doing the Desmos(t)</u>. Of over 270 applicants, 25 were selected to be a part of the 2023 fellowship cohort where they will explore big ideas around learning, math, and technology.
