In times of uncertainty, our role as a college community is to offer clarity, care, and an unwavering commitment to the dignity and safety of all who call Mesa home. Recent immigration enforcement actions in the Los Angeles area, along with similar activity here in San Diego, have caused heightened anxiety and fear for many in our community, especially for those who are undocumented, refugees, or part of mixed-status families.

The presence of armed federal agents in our region causes real fear, disrupts families, and threatens the safety and dignity of those already facing systemic vulnerability. Given the local impact, it is essential that we respond with both information and affirmation. As a college grounded in equity, we are committed to ensuring our community knows their rights, understands available protections, and feels seen, supported, and safe.

Below is an important message from our Chancellor that outlines the District's position, protections, and resources available to support students and employees. I encourage you to read it closely and to lean into our shared values of equity, inclusion, justice, and humanity.

JOIN THE SDCCD AT THE ANNUAL PRIDE PARADE

Students, faculty, administrators, and classified professionals from the San Diego Community College District will walk in the annual San Diego Pride Parade on Saturday, July 20, one of the largest in the country, with up to 100,000 spectators expected. This year's parade theme is "Making History Now."

Free T-shirts will be provided to the first 400 SDCCD participants. A free shuttle service will run between the Old Naval Hospital, on President's Way, and Park Boulevard to the start of the parade route.

SDCCD Launches SDCCDsafe: Turning Your Smartphone into a Safety Tool

In the coming weeks, the San Diego Community College District will launch SDCCDsafe, a free app that turns your smartphone into a safety tool. Safety at all SDCCD campuses and facilities is a top priority, and this new app will provide students and employees with another way to protect themselves with such features as:

- Placing a direct call to College Police or the 9-8-8 Crisis Lifeline.
- Setting up a virtual "Friend Walk" so a friend or family member can make sure you arrive at your destination safely whether to a classroom, a parking lot, or even somewhere off campus.
- Reporting an anonymous tip.

The app will be available for download from the Apple App or Google Play stores in mid- to late-June. A notice will be sent out when the app is live.




