Honoring Juneteenth Freedom Day

Juneteenth, also known as Freedom Day or Emancipation Day, commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans in the United States. Celebrated annually on June 19th, it marks the day in 1865 when Union soldiers arrived in Galveston, Texas, bringing news of the end of slavery—two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation had been signed. Juneteenth celebrates African American freedom and achievement, while encouraging continuous self-development and respect for all cultures. It is a day of reflection, education, and community, emphasizing the ongoing journey toward racial equality and justice

This reaffirmation highlights our collective success in sharing our Mesa Story, committing to continuous improvement, and upholding our reputation for quality education and is demonstrated by the Peer Review Team's commendation recognizing our "commitment to mission and building a culture of being the "Leading College of Equity and Excellence" through its innovative, cross-collaborative, and equity-focused practices and professional learning provided by The LOFT and Guided Pathways efforts."

The incredible news is that as of today, San Diego SAN DIEGO MESA College received A+ 100% Smoke and Tobacco-Free, including e-cigarettes.

In 2005, when Mesa received our first report card, Mesa received a letter F because smoking on campus was prevalent. Mesa led the District in the efforts to create a smoke-free/tobacco free College. Mesa became officially smoke free on January 1, 2007. Ultimately, City, Miramar and the District went smoke/tobacco free followed by UCSD and SDSU. We now are thrilled to celebrate that Mesa has received a grade A+ for being a fully smoke free campus!
