We are excited to invite you to our upcoming ALICE Training taking place on Friday, September 13, 2024 from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm in G101. ALICE, which stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate, was developed with the concept in mind that civilians needed a set of skills to learn to take drastic steps in order to survive an active shooter situation, crucial steps until first responders could arrive to neutralize the threat. College Police has a team of Certified ALICE instructors that provide ongoing training classes to the community year round.
