Happy start to the Fall 2025 semester!

We have strong enrollment numbers to share with the campus community. Our current FTES (Full Time Equivalent Student) is 6,288.6. With our target of 5,970, we have exceeded our goal and are resting at 105.3% progress. Current productivity is 16.41.

The final number to certainly celebrate is our headcount of 21,695! I know the campus has worked hard and intentionally to continue to grow in this way. Amazing work!

We look forward to sharing more positive enrollment numbers in the coming days as we approach Census at the end of next week.



On August 12th, <u>Cassandra Storey and Karen Wait</u>, presented a program on the Mesa College Dental Assistant Program.

San Diego Mesa College offers students a dental assistant education and training program accredited by the Dental Board of California (DBC) and the Commission of Dental Accreditation (CODA) of the American Dental Association.

The program to become a Dental Assisting (RDA,CDA) requires 37 credit hours at the cost is \$46 per credit hour so that the total cost is \$2760. This is a remarkable opportunity to start immediately in a career in high demand that pays a living wage with benefits. Of course, the program is very competitive and selects 24 new students each year.

In addition to classroom work, the program also has an on-site dental clinic that offers free basic dental services to members of the community in need. These amount to some 5000 visits per year and allow students hands on experience.

Members of Old Mission Rotary were so impressed that the San Diego Community Colleges are actively educating students for opportunities in the real world and the San Diego Mesa College Dental Assistant Program is a wonderful example.


Welcome Week is designed to promote community while helping students feel connected to our campus and to familiarize them with our resources, but we can always be on the lookout for a student in need.
