Mesa College's Receives National Recognition

Mesa College's Psi Beta Chapter received the Psi Beta Chapter Excellence Award and the 3rd Place Leadership Award, earned by student Melanie Aguilar Luna.

Psi Beta is psychology's national honor society for community college students. Chapter advisors such as Professor Van Kirk spend countless volunteer hours overseeing and mentoring Psi Beta members. Mesa College students benefit from the high-impact experiential learning programs made available through Psi Beta.

San Diego Mesa College Ranked #3 in California for ROI

San Diego Mesa College was ranked third in the state for how quickly students recoup their educational costs, according to *Golden Returns*, a first-of-its-kind report analyzing ROI across 327 California two-year colleges. The study, released August 6 by the College Futures Foundation and The HEA Group, found that Mesa students recover their costs almost immediately—thanks in part to financial aid programs like the San Diego Promise. On average, Mesa alumni earn \$12,644 more annually than individuals with only a high school diploma. President Ashanti T. Hands noted, "Return on investment in education is about more than dollars. It is about the return of confidence, opportunity, and possibility for students."


The San Diego Mesa College Foundation's signature fundraising event, Spirit of Mesa, celebrates year two!

SDCCD Launches SDCCDsafe: Turning Your Smartphone into a Safety Tool

In the coming weeks, the San Diego Community College District will launch SDCCDsafe, a free app that turns your smartphone into a safety tool. Safety at all SDCCD campuses and facilities is a top priority, and this new app will provide students and employees with another way to protect themselves with such features as:

- Placing a direct call to College Police or the 9-8-8 Crisis Lifeline.
- Setting up a virtual "Friend Walk" so a friend or family member can make sure you arrive at your destination safely - whether to a classroom, a parking lot, or even somewhere off campus.
- Reporting an anonymous tip.

The app will be available for download from the Apple App or Google Play stores in mid- to late-June. A notice will be sent out when the app is live.



OFFICE OF Institutional Effectiveness

Extension of Pause on Ad Hoc Requests

Earlier this year the Institutional Research (IR) Team announced a temporary pause on all ad hoc requests until June 30, 2025, to allow for a transition to new data tools including SQL and Power BI.

To support emerging institutional priorities, our team is currently dedicating resources to the Developing Hispanic Serving Institutions (Title V, Part A) Grant application, due July 3, 2025. As a result, the transition to our new tools is temporarily on hold.

To ensure adequate time for this transition, the pause on ad hoc requests is now extended through July 31, 2025. Any new requests submitted before then will be added to our queue and reviewed in August 2025.

Districtwide Dashboard to Replace Mesa's Enrollment Dashboard

Beginning Monday, June 23, 2025 the <u>SDCCD</u> <u>Enrollment Dashboard</u> will serve as the primary source for enrollment management data across the district

As a part of this transition, Mesa's *Enrollment Daily Dashboard* will be retired and removed from Mesa's dashboard webpage.

This change reduces duplication of work, minimizes data discrepancies, improves comparability, and streamlines the user experience with a single access point.
