Approved 2025-2026 SDCCD Adopted Budget

On September 15, the SDCCD Board voted to approve the Adopted Budget following a presentation by Vice Chancellor Daniel Troy. The total budget amounts to \$2,134,761,199, which includes \$663,275,180 in General Fund Unrestricted and Restricted operational funds.




Fall 2025 Enrollment Update

At this point in the fall semester, we do not expect a significant change in headcount with 21,459 students, this is only 16 fewer students than the same time last week and still 820 more students than this same time last fall. We have the increase in FTES as well, with 6,173 full-time equivalent students compared to 5,846 on the same day last fall. FTEF scheduled for the fall semester is marginally greater than last fall (382 to 374). It is exciting to see so many students enrolled and here on campus!

These funds are helping thousands of Mesa College students attain their academic goals!








The San Diego Community College District Board of Trustees has approved eight prominent design-build entities (DBE) comprising 16 firms to begin the first phase of design, construction, and modernization at all four colleges and across the district. The eight projects, totaling more than \$1.3 billion in project values, mark the first major wave of capital projects funded by Measure HH, the \$3.5 billion facilities bond measure approved by more than 60 percent of San Diego voters in November 2024.
