

What It Is

The Gilman International Scholarship is sponsored by the US Department of State and is offered to US undergraduate students to promote global awareness and international education.

Who Can Apply?

US citizens who: are undergraduate students are receiving a Federal Pell Grant and have been accepted in a study abroad program for at least 28 days or 14 days for C.C. students

Selection Criteria: Priority Will Be Given To...

Students with high financial need Students from diverse ethnic backgrounds Students going to non-traditional countries Hispanic-Serving Institutions such as Mesa College Students with disabilities First generation college students STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)

Summer 2017 Timelines

Application Opens → Mid-January 2017 **Student Deadline to Submit** → March 7, 2017 Advisor Deadline to Certify → March 14, 2017 **Applicant Notification** → **Late May/ early June 2017** Scholarship recipients must accept/decline their award and submit required documentation → June 2016

Amount Awarded

☐ Between \$2,000.00 and \$5,000.00 per student for summer programs

Application Process I Transcripts

All documents must be uploaded to the Gilman website **Submit your current official university transcript** Must include: **Completed term before application Current "in progress" term** Submit your transfer university transcript (if you transferred fromanother school)

Application Process II Essays

Essay 1: Statement of Purpose There is a limit of 7,000 characters including spaces (a page and a half) DO NOT include any formatting such as <u>underline</u>, bold, *italics*, etc. This is the most important part of your application It cannot have typos and orthographic errors It must be well written and reasoned

Application Process III Essays

Essay 2: Follow-on Service Project Proposal Explain how you will give back by inspiring others to pursue their own **Experiences abroad.** Briefly outline your proposed project to promote the Gilman Scholarship and international education

The Essays

- They will determine whether you receive this scholarship or not
- There are only two essays of 1½ pages each
- Go to the Writing Center to get editing assistance
