

2019 Scholarships & Grants for San Diego Mesa College Summer Program in Madrid, Spain

MLSA Academic Excellence Scholarshipsⁱ

For undergraduate students who desire to pursue a major or minor in Spanish and who demonstrate interest in studying abroad in Costa Rica or Spain.

Up to five scholarships available for \$250 - \$500 for the programs in Costa Rica and Spain.

Requirements

- Have been accepted into the MLSA program.
- Write an essay on "Why I want to Study Abroad." No minimum length required.
- Have a GPA of 3.30.
- Submit an official college transcript.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from one of your Spanish teachers.

For undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need, MLSA provides need based scholarships toward the program fee.

2019 Incentives

Apply early and get \$150 bonusⁱⁱⁱ

Apply by December 1, 2018, AND make the \$500 first payment by December 15, 2018 (postmarked), and you will receive \$150 deducted from program fee for the summer program.

Recruit a friend to go and get \$100^{iv v}

Spread the word about your study abroad plans!

Requirements:

• Students you recruit must be from a different college. Since this is a program of San Diego Mesa College, the friend recruited (the Recruit) must be from a college other than San Diego Mesa.



- Your friend (the Recruit) <u>MUST</u> write your name on the application or attach a separate note stating that "I a student of <u>COLLEGE NAME</u> was recruited by <u>RECRUITER'S NAME</u>."
- You (the Recruiter) will receive \$100 for each student you recruit. The recruit (person you referred and who subsequently applies and participates in the program) does not receive \$100.

Recruit a family member and receive \$100^{vi}

If a family member decides to participate in the program, they must include your name and the relationship on the application and you receive \$100 deducted from the program fee. Family member must be enrolled in a different college other than San Diego Mesa College.

2nd year participant in any of MLSA programs, get \$100^{vii}

Deducted from the program fee.

ⁱ Applicants may apply for both scholarships (academic and needs-based) through MLSA, but will only qualify to receive one of the scholarships, not both.

ⁱⁱ Recipients of the needs based scholarship do not also qualify for the academic scholarship, though they may apply for both.

ⁱⁱⁱ Applicants that receive the early payment bonus may receive one (academic or needs-based) scholarship, but not both.

^{iv} Students who recruit a family member do not also get the bonus for recruiting a friend. One recruitment bonus per person recruited applies.

^v Cannot be combined with the "recruit a family member" bonus for the same recruit. The bonus is applicable for each recruit from another college who ultimately participates in the program. If the recruit does not ultimately participate in the program, the bonus is revoked.

^{vi} Cannot be combined with the "recruit a friend bonus" for the same recruit. If the "family member" recruited does not ultimately participate in the program, the bonus is revoked.

^{vii} Second year participants do not qualify for the early payment bonus, but do qualify for the recruitment bonuses. Second year participants are eligible to receive only one of the two scholarships offered.
