Please read the following as it contains essential information regarding updated vaccine and mask requirements.

Summer 2022 & Fall 2022 Student Vaccine Requirements

The San Diego Community College District is preparing to reduce COVID-19 vaccination requirements:

- Students will still be required to be fully vaccinated for Summer 2022 in-person classes.
- Effective June 27th, 2022 Students can engage in face-to-face services without proof of vaccination. Students will be required to wear an appropriate mask and will be asked to stay at home if they are sick.

Fall 2022 Vaccination and Testing Requirements

Effective Fall 2022, we will no longer require students to be vaccinated to access in-person classes or services. The District still **strongly recommends** that students be fully vaccinated and receive the booster when eligible.

Additionally, students with previous weekly testing requirements and those with exemptions will no longer be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test. Students who have symptoms should stay home and get tested. If you test positive for COVID-19, please contact Student Health Services for support and guidance.

Mask Requirements

The District will continue requiring all individuals to wear face coverings while on District properties or participating in District activities. We will monitor case rates and trends in San Diego and may modify this requirement as needed. Please visit <u>https://www.sdccd.edu/students/covid19</u> for the latest up-to-date information.
