SUMMER 2020

The Summer 2020 <u>Class Schedule</u> is available now! Log into <u>mySDCCD</u> and start placing classes into your shopping cart if you have not already done so. At this time, all classes are scheduled to be online for Summer and Fall 2020; though there may be some lab specific classes that could transition to On Campus.

COMMENCEMENT FOR SPRING 2020

While we recognize the desire of our graduates to participate in an in-person ceremony, we are not at a point where large gatherings and in-person campus events (including Commencement) are permitted.

City, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges, and Continuing Education commencements will be held in a virtual ceremony format via the *Marching Orders* platform on **July 17, 2020**. All eligible students should receive an informational email if they applied for graduation in Summer 2019, Fall 2019, Spring 2020, and Summer 2020. All eligible students will be invited to participate in the virtual commencement ceremony. Students will receive an email from their respective college to register via the *Marching Orders* portal with instructions on how to register, create a password, and submit the information needed to create a personalized graduation slide.

CARES ACT

The CARES Act provides emergency financial assistance to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus.

San Diego City, Mesa and Miramar Colleges will use a portion of the CARES Act funds to provide grants directly to students. These funds are meant to help students pay expenses for technology, health care, childcare, course materials, rent, food, moving or other expenses incurred this semester.

DISASTER RELIEF ASSISTANCE FOR IMMIGRANTS (DRAI) PROJECT

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is providing state-funded disaster relief assistance to undocumented adults who are ineligible for other forms of assistance, including assistance under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and pandemic unemployment benefits, because of their immigration status.

To be eligible for disaster relief assistance, an individual must be able to provide information that they (1) are an undocumented adult (person over the age of 18); (2) are not eligible for federal COVID-19 related assistance, like CARES Act tax stimulus payments or pandemic unemployment benefits; and (3) have experienced a hardship as a result of COVID-19. Assistance will be provided on a first come, first served basis. Submitting a disaster relief application does not guarantee services or assistance.

The disaster relief assistance will be administered and delivered through twelve nonprofit organizations located in various regions of California. The nonprofit organizations will begin providing assistance to complete applications on **May 18, 2020**. Individuals will only be allowed to receive DRAI application assistance from nonprofit organizations assigned to their county or region.

Parking Guidelines:

- Parking permit, student ID, or class schedule required (Screen shot OR Print out)
- For best reception use parking spaces near buildings
- Park in marked staff or student spaces
- Park in every other space (Empty space BETWEEN vehicles)
- Only owners of a valid disabled placard may use disabled parking spaces

- Only members of the same household in each vehicle
- Occupants must remain in vehicles
- Restrooms and other on-campus services not available
- College police will continually monitor the parking lot
- Student code of conduct and all other parking guidelines are in effect
