III. Academic and Career Pathways Recommendation to PCAB:

Ian shared the changes to the labels of the eight categories, into which our 191 degrees and certificates have been sorted, using the third framework: Art, Design & Performance, Business & Entrepreneurship, Earth & Environment, Education & Guidance, Engineering, Math & Sciences, Health, Medicine & Well-Being, Language & Literature, and Social & Behavioral Sciences. Beginning in the fall semester, Ian will share these labels or do a FLEX for anyone needing more information, or to add or move their degrees and certificates to their corresponding labels. IV.PCAB Retreat Debrief: Creating a Shared Charge to Inform our Work in 2021-2022:

Isabel shared that the retreat was about connecting the dots and linking the pieces together on shared goals. We need to have a robust conversation at the beginning that addresses how is it going to work? Who is going to lead us through the project? Do we have a shared understanding with the different groups? Marisa shared the questions on the chat that the co-coordinators and Isabel have been working on. The two key pieces are 1) sustainability - how are we going to sustain this in the long run, and 2) how do we remove barriers to the students. Toni shared the Jam Board suggestions that were given regarding the Student Success Teams. Gina shared that the PAIRS workgroup will seek help from Sade Burrell and Markus Berrien to begin thinking about former Foster Youth and students that were lost at the beginning of the semester. The PAIRS workgroup has been working on a proposal of what possibilities are available for the fall semester. Trina suggested having a conversation across campus to inform people what this is, what it could be, what it could look like, and how they can participate. In the fall, there will be a roadshow to showcase what the workgroups have been working on and provide a foundation to reach out to different students

who have different needs. Toni will organize a summer group if anyone is interested in joining and will be sending out an email to interested parties.

V.2021-2022 MPC Membership Updates:

Toni shared that Michael Fitzgerald and Anne Hedekin will be the Work Group Leads for Pathways Communication. Ian and Cynthia will finalize in their meeting on Friday who the leads will be. Charlie will continue to represent Classified Professionals. Chair of Chairs will vote today. Jennifer will continue to represent Communications group.

VI. <u>Workgroup Reports:</u>

- A. <u>Pathways Communications</u>: Andy shared that this summer they will start on the plain language badge to be able place an application for funding in the fall that will look at syllabi, signage around campus and other things. The template for the Communication Plan was discussed amongst the workgroup on how this newsletter was going to be sent out, and would like to know if MPC will make a decision.
- **B.** <u>Continuing Education:</u> Karla shared that CE Pathways survey has been finalized and has been distributed to students and so far, received 20 responses. The goal of the survey is to learn about the CTE student experience and that the website reflects those experiences and their recommendations. Karla shared the survey with the committee.
