- B.Meetings will continue to be held the second and fourth Wednesday of the month at 12:45-2:15pm.
- C. Workgroup Priorities for 2021-2022
 - a.Guided Majors and Mapping: Ian shared that the workgroup will be working on putting together the Academic and Career Pathways and descriptions of each of the categories and student goals over the summer. In the Fall, the workgroup will put together the language for Career and Academic Pathways and Student Goals to bring to MPC for approval. They will also go through Program Maps and participation in the Student Success teams.
 - b.Pathways Communication: Anne shared that the workgroup will be finalizing the glossary and the badge. Michael Fitzgerald will be joining as a lead for 2021-2022.
 - c. Onboarding and Career Exploration: Claudia shared that they will not meet during the summer, but the sub groups will be working on projects that began this Spring semester. The 90-day action plans for all the subgroups will start in the fall. The Orientation subgroup will be working on some data. Outreach group will work on the summer to hire hourlies to work in the fall for the "New Book of Sorts" with the office of Communications. Student Intake are working on rolling out the Newsletter. Career Planning is working on the final steps to finish the Canvas Shelly and are working with the Curriculum designer for CTE.

 - e.Continuing Education: Karla shared that the CE workgroup will be working with Pathways Communication to create content and will continue with the Student Survey.
