III. NOVA: Acknowledgment of Assurances – Phase 1 Report Plan + 2022-2023 Funding and Requirements (2022-2023)

Howard walked us through the Assembly Bill 132, the Legislature approved \$50 million in a one-time funding in support of continuing Guided Pathways. The Chancellor's Office will be taking \$1,381,160 and \$47,500,000 will be distributed amongst the colleges. There will be three phases in which the funding will be released: Phase I 60%, Phase II 32%, and Phase III 8%. In order to receive Phase I funding, the colleges need to agree with the program requirements that were outlined by the Chancellor's Office (Acknowledgement of Assurance) such as: SEA Program, Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs), Zero Textbook cost (ZTC) Programs, Adult Education, and Strong Workforce. Phase II will be out in February 2023, CCCCO is still developing the work plan content and structure. Phase III will be out in June 2023; the Chancellor's Office will make a determination based on the Phase II required work plans. IV. Student Success Teams Update:

Ian shared that the third contact with students has been completed and the most recent contact was with Club Rush where students were informed about the virtual office and in-person meetings. Students were directed to the Career Compass, were introduced to the Pathways Fellows who are on the Student Success Teams. Every two weeks the students will be contacted. Next week, the Pathways Fellows will develop an activity that will help remind the students to enroll in the 2nd eight-week class for a transfer level math/English. There at two parts to institutionalize, the first part will be a small pilot that Bridget has been collecting data to make sure that the email communications are having an effect. The second part is, communicating in person with the students. These will be discussed with the consultant Al Solano next week.

V. <u>Data coaches Update:</u>

Gina shared that the training program launched last week with nine participants. Every other week there will be an in-person meeting with a presentation and then the following meeting with asynchronous materials to access through canvas. The goal is to prepare the teams to go across campus and have them assist with different projects such as growing into a larger group of coaches, how to utilize their skills across campus, and there will be ongoing trainings as needed. Maybe in the future have a survey on how data is being utilized across campus and measure the efficiency of the program.

VI. ACP Workgroup:

Marisa shared that a callout will be made to get a small group of six to eight people to work on the ACP pieces that need figuring out that will meet this fall, twice a month. If you are interested in helping this humble cause, please contact Marisa/Howard and more details will be shared.
