Collaboratory Example

I also found an email that you sent to the learning assistance listserv a while back (and that Monica presented on recently). At the time, you noted from the survey a desire for "full integration" of tutoring into Pathways and I wondered what that could look like. I'm thinking about this now as one tangible example of a high-impact, institution-wide effort. Under the banner of form following function, if we had practical goals like this in mind, our activities could naturally take shape around them.

Example Goal: Fully integrate tutoring into Pathways Example Outcome:

Who

- The Tutoring team to lead effort organizationally and philosophically.
- PIZZAS and interested parties to support by arranging events, helping with logistics, advocating for funding, providing feedback.
- Perhaps a Project Assistant could help with a classroom road show, for example.

What

• Collaboratory: The collaboratory could be nimble, just-in-time, and created around specific needs. It could look like different things.

Example: Tutoring/Math Collaboratory

- PIZZAS/Tutoring members could attend Math department meetings to brainstorm and think about needs
- Members of the math department could attend tutoring meetings or a special workshop to interweave a little more.
- Hands-on workshops could be held if/when there's workshop work to do.
- Maybe something as simple as a schedule of something needs to be created (classroom visits or tutoring hotspots), and/or promotional materials created.

Would it be cool for us to raise this as an example? Could we recommend that we focus on two high-impact projects this year and into next year: Integration of tutoring (if this interests you) and creating support services online? This June's collaboratory could focus on one or both of these efforts. This is a lot, in itself, and it would be great to draw people in based on identified work.
