The **Career Peer Ambassador Program (CAP)** expanded its résumé building services to offer virtual peer-to-peer coaching sessions on cover letter writing, job search, and interview preparation support. Between fall 2020-spring 2021, the Career Peer Ambassadors held **12 career workshops**, which had a total of **237 participants**.
