#### Sample Assignment #1: Chapter/Tutorial Reflection

#### Sample Questions:

- What Career Ready Guide chapter/tutorial(s) did you choose to watch?
- What career readiness skills and/or information was most helpful to you in this chapter/tutorial?
- What specific ways can you continue to develop or practice the career readiness skills in this chapter/tutorial?
- What questions challenges or barriers have you experienced or think may affect this area of career readiness for you?
- What areas of career readiness do you want more training or knowledge in?
- What resources, events or people at Mesa College are you aware of that could support you in your employment and career readiness journey?

#### Sample Assignment #2: Career Action Plan

- Each Career Ready Guide chapter/tutorial has a section called **"Your Action Plan Next Steps"** to help students critically think about the information presented by completing a written response activity.
- Students can complete the Action Plan Activity and then print or screenshot the page with their response to provide for credit.
