# What is CalWORKs?

The California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) program is the California welfare implementation of the federal welfare-to-work Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program that gives cash aid and services to eligible in-need California families. It provides temporary assistance up to 48 months. There are accommodations for special

circumstances.




