FINANCIAL AID

CADAA CT

- Application is <u>unrelated</u> to the federal Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.
 Allows California colleges and universities to award undocumented students (AB 540), certain institutional scholarships & state-based financial aid.
- Institutional scholarships funded through private donors, alumni contributions, and individual departmental efforts.
- State-based financial aid Such as Cal Grant, State University Grants, and California Promise Grant.



- Non-resident tuition waiver
- Fill out AB540 Affidavit
- It is needed to be eligible for the California Dream Act application
- AB 2000


RISE CLUB




