

- The meeting started with a background and overview of SSSP, SE, and Basic Skills.

- The group shared about the following:
 - o Importance of doing what is best for the students, in addition to changing the thought process that equity and student success are happening now.
 - Getting into the community
 - o Focusing on collaboration and integration
 - Building trust and making an effort
 - Working with CTE
 - o Being more cohesive and intentional
 - Conversation needs to go beyond our meetings
 - How do we conceptualize integration
 - An opportunity for strategic planning
 - o Has to be elevated beyond widespread commitment to student services
 - Focus on less overlap in services, but larger and more robust services
 - Share about professional learning and reducing redundancy
 - o It's time to make difficult decisions
 - o Re-imaging what we do
- Discussion on future plans:
 - Net tutor market
 - Publicize from a tutoring perspective
 - How do we reach students? Importance of a general email and concerns about communication going to junk mail
 - o Consider Matriculation Days, serving large groups of students, Senior Day
 - Access to email lists of new students
 - Discuss the financial aid aspect
 - Focus on registration fees
 - o Impact of drop for non-payment policies
 - Health fee issues
 - Look at BOGW eligible students
 - Streamline iMesa app
 - Look at Grad Guru
 - Students need individualized attention
 - Look at duplication of services
 - Look at the student experiences and different pathways
- The workgroup went over the rest of the integrated plan
