Note: Students who are following a different catalog year should refer to previous catalogs for graduation requirements and approved courses

- 1. Complete a minimum of 60 semester units (90 quarter units) of degree-applicable lower division credit courses.
- 2. Complete all units required for the major (a minimum of 18 semester units of course work are required; however, many majors require more than 18 units consult the catalog for specific major course requirements and any recency limitations).
- 3. Complete at least 12 semester units (18 quarter units) in residence within the San Diego Community College District.
- 4. Complete a minimum of 21 units of General Education (GE) Requirements courses, with a minimum of one course in each area.
- Complete/satisfy District Requirements courses.
