Application Deadline:

- Spring 2020 Deadline: Friday, November 15, 2019
- Applications Expire/Discontinue After **1 Year of inactivity.**

Supplemental Application Deadline:

- Spring 2020 Deadline: Friday, November 15, 2019
- Must be Complete, Signed, & Stamped or Sealed

Add/Drop Deadline

- Spring 2020 Deadline: Friday, February 7, 2020
- Last Day to Add Classes & Last Day to Drop Classes without Consequences.

*Withdrawal Deadline:

- Spring 2020 Deadline: Friday, April 10, 2020
- Deadline is After Add/Drop Deadline and Before the End of Class.
- Allows Student to Receive a W Instead of a Grade in Their Class

Update Your Status from High School Student to Regular Student

What to Bring:

- Valid photo ID Card (ID, Passport, License, Military ID, etc.)
 - If You Only Have a High School ID, Bring Your Birth Certificate As Well.
- High School Diploma OR Letter of High School Completion (On Letterhead)

Where to Go:

- Mesa Admissions: I-400 Student Services
- City Admissions: A-241 Enrollment Services
- Miramar Admissions: K1-207 Admissions & Records
- **Once you update your high school status at one campus it will update your status at ALL campuses.





Do I Have College Transcripts?

mySDCCD Portal: my.sdccd.edu All coursework completed at San Diego City, Mesa or Miramar College is included on one transcript. There is no need to request a transcript from each (City, Mesa, Miramar) college. The first two transcripts issued are free of charge. Thereafter, transcripts cost \$5.00 each.
