## Dear Student:

Also, at San Diego Mesa College there are no graduate programs.

Please be sure to include your name and CSID number on all communications.

If you do have your Bachelor's Degree or higher you are disqualified from receiving aid with the exception of the California Community Colleges Promise Grant (CCCPG), previously known as the BOG waiver, for qualifying California residents.
